The award ceremony was held at Chinese Community Church on June 8th, 2019 at 12 noon. One of our students, Sophia Sacchetto (沈冰) won the honorable mention award at the beginner level. The school and teachers believe the essay contest was a great opportunity for our students to practice their Chinese writing.



Adult/Child CPR & First-aid Training



When a person becomes suddenly ill or injured there is a critical period before medical assistance arrives. Every year, we ensure all of our staff and teachers are CPR & First-aid

certified. This helps ensure our teachers are prepared for medical emergencies at the school. On August 3rd, 2019, we had 10 staff and teachers attended the four hours training presented by Save-A-Life Educators. All were successfully certified.
